Subject: Certification Scheme for Remotely Piloted Aircraft System (RPAS)

DGCA has issued Civil Aviation Regulations (CAR) Section 3, Series X, Part I titled as 'Requirements for Operation of Civil Remotely Piloted Aircraft System (RPAS)'. The above stated CAR specifies the minimum standards for manufacturing of RPAS.

In this regard, DGCA has signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with Quality Council of India (QCI) to develop and operate a Certification Scheme for Remotely Piloted Aircraft Systems in line with DGCA requirements.

All the RPA manufacturers, who desire to obtain certification for their RPAS model may approach Quality Council of India (QCI) (<u>https://www.qcin.org/RPAS.php</u>). Further, all manufacturers, whose various RPAS models have been provisionally accepted by DGCA are also advised to approach Quality Council of India for certification of their respective provisionally accepted RPAS models. No new application for provisional acceptance of RPAS model will be accepted by DGCA henceforth.
